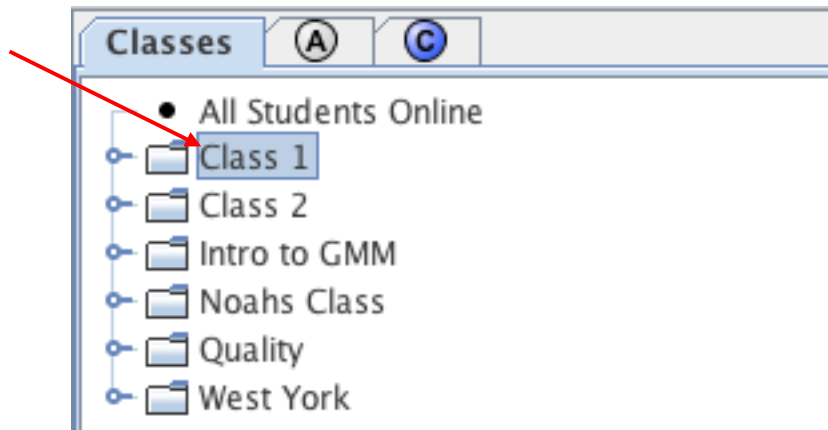




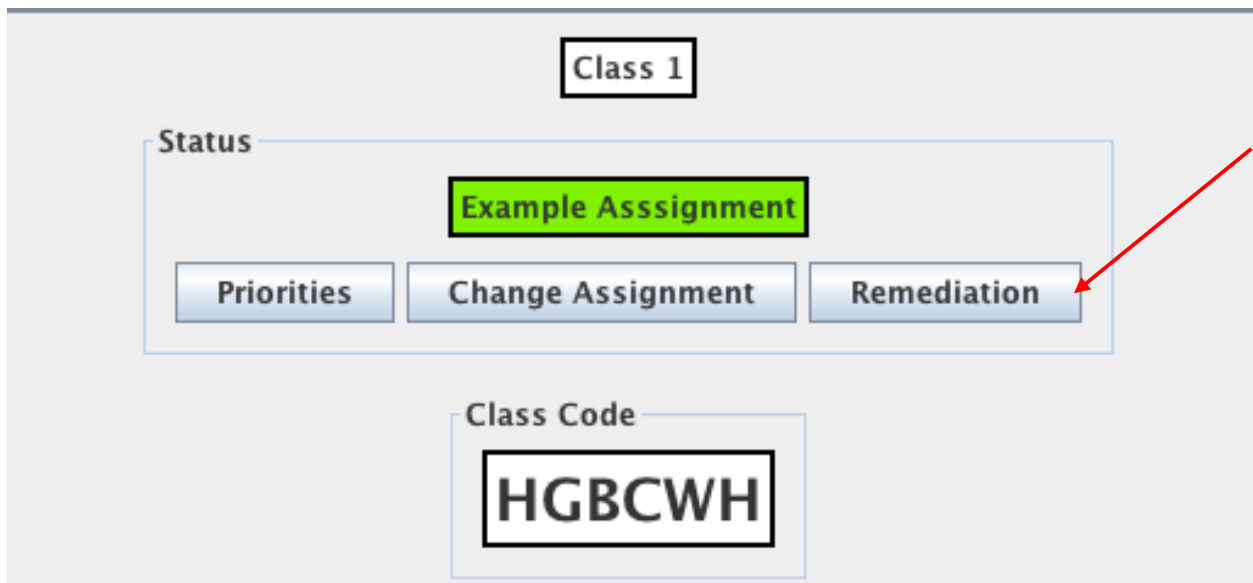
## Keystone Remediation

Get More Math offers a pre-made program for students that require Keystone Remediation.

1. Select the class that you would like to place in remediation mode.

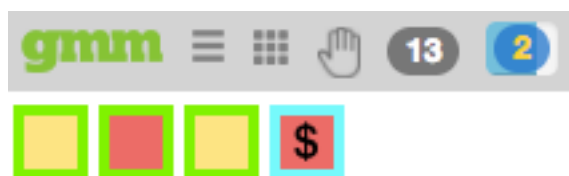


2. Select the **Remediation** button.



**That's it! Your students are set to work through the Get More Math Keystone Remediation program. It's that simple. However, if you'd like to know more about how it works, feel free to keep reading.**

3. The remediation mode is pre-set with a list of about 60 skills that could show up on the Keystone Algebra test. When in this mode, GMM starts at the top of that list and adds problems to the student's screen until there are two red problems. When the student advances to yellow on either of the red problems, the next problem from the list will be added.



GMM will ensure that there are always two red squares.

4. GMM will cycle back through all the problems as usual, so as more squares get added, progress will slow down. Also, note that the specific topics are sorted to present simplest or most likely to occur on the test first. In other words, the order may feel scrambled, as it is not laid out in traditional sequence.
5. The tool is intended for long, steady growth in an ongoing remediation setting. If you have only a few students in the class who are in need of remediation, consider creating a separate class for those students. If you choose not to create a separate class, you will simply need to click on the Remediation button whenever you'd like your class to work within this mode. They will remain in remediation until you assign something new or switch the class to Priorities.
