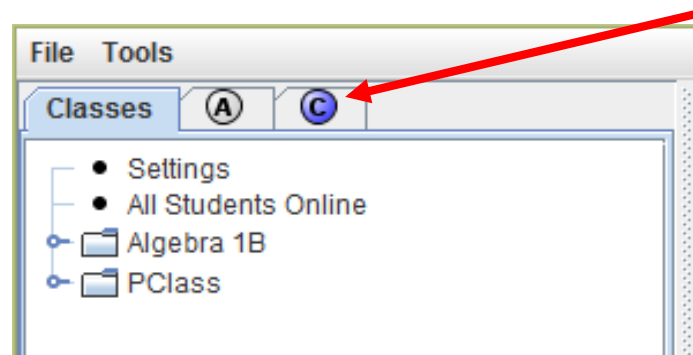




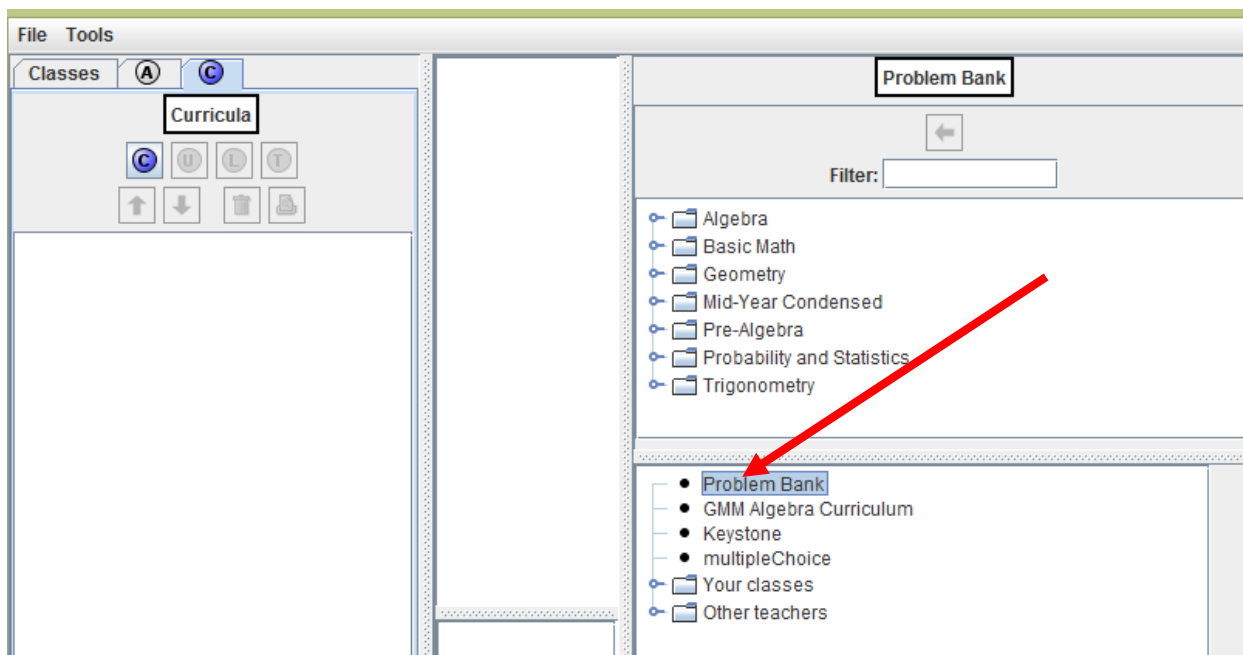
Viewing and Using Prepared Curricula

Get More Math offers the possibility of creating or borrowing entire curricula for different subject areas. A curriculum is a preselected collection of problem types, made in advance or borrowed from another teacher. Power Point slides and worksheets can be embedded among the problem banks of designated skills for student practice.

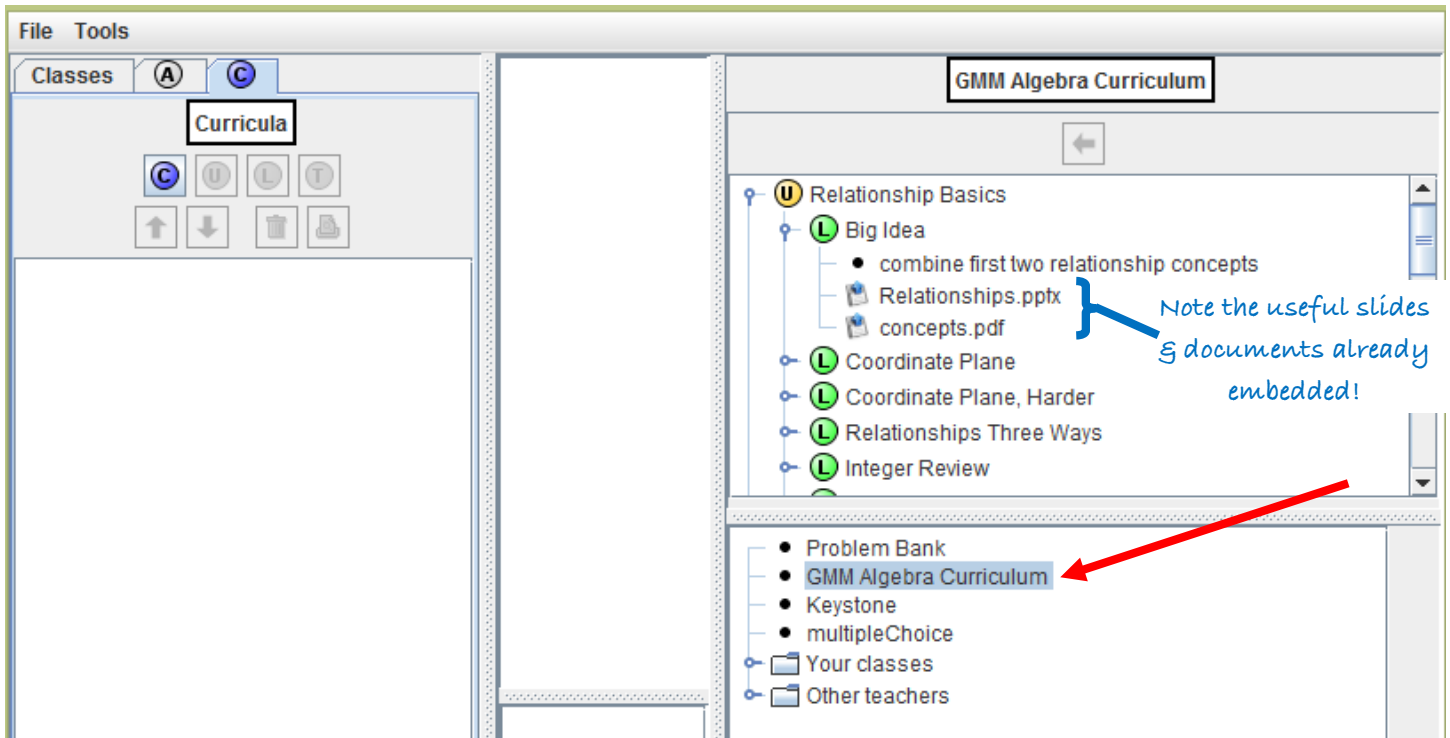
1. In your teacher account, select the tab marked with the blue "C" for **Curricula**.



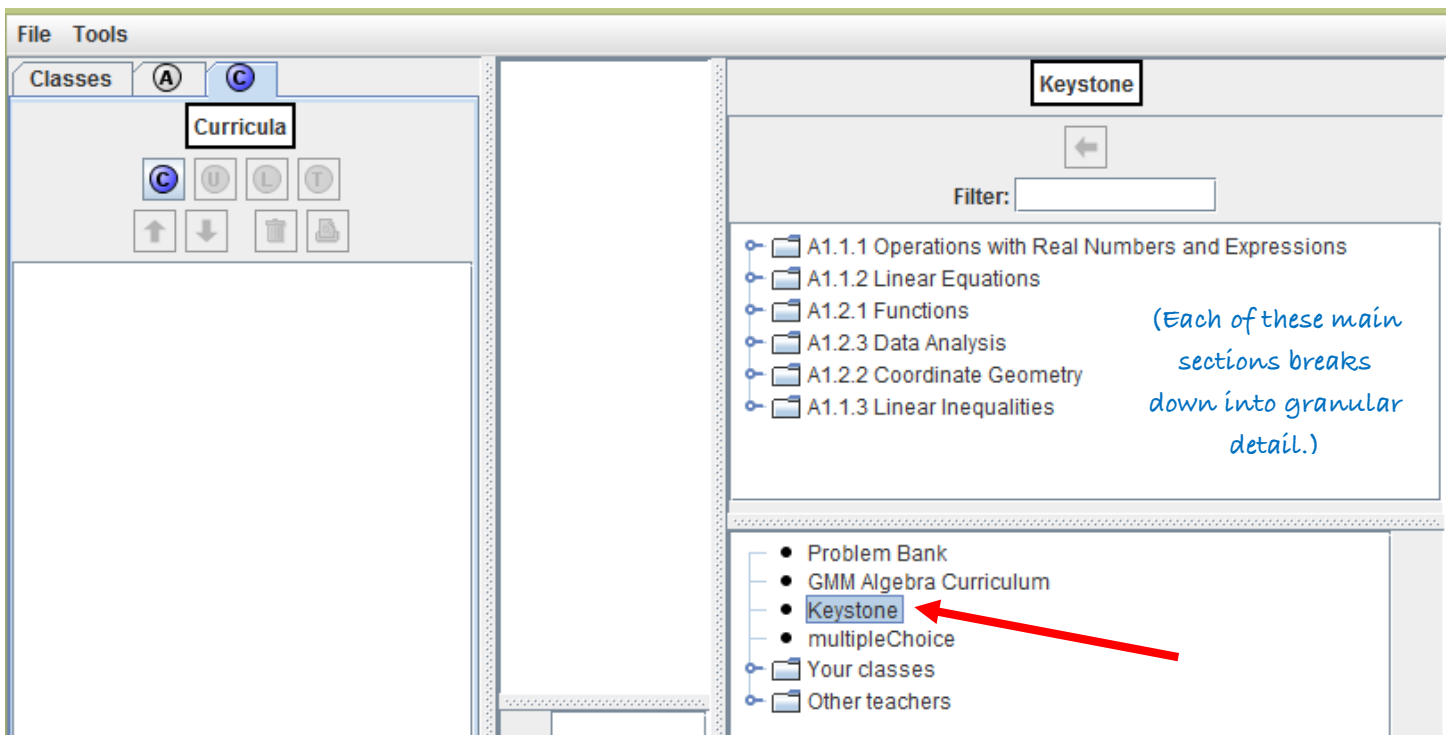
2. Select any source from the list on the lower right panel. Selecting **Problem Bank** will call up Get More Math's regular collection of skills:



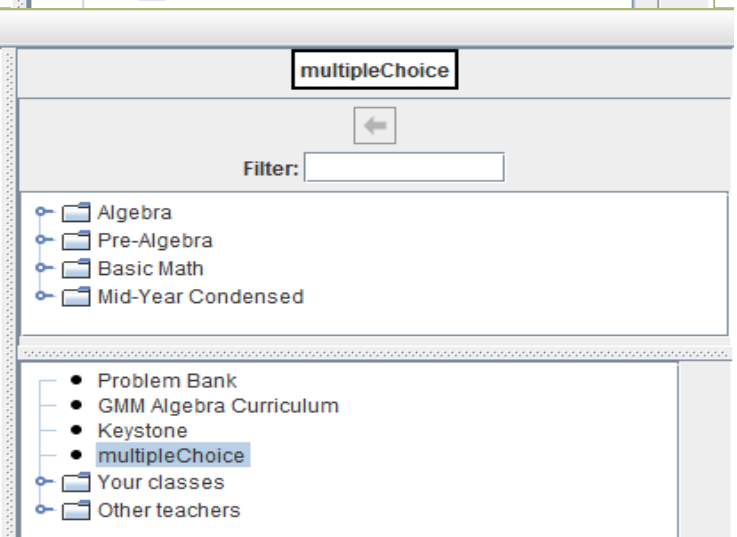
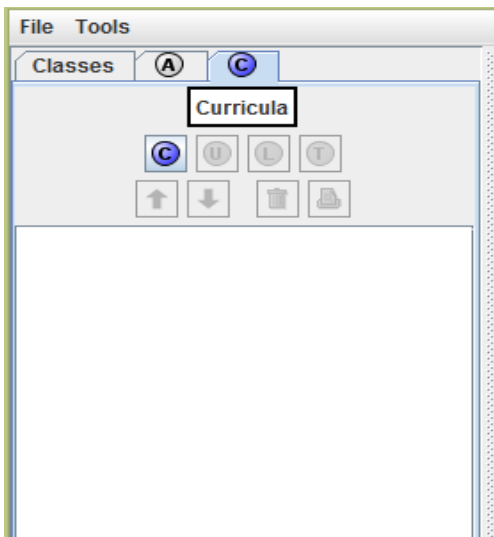
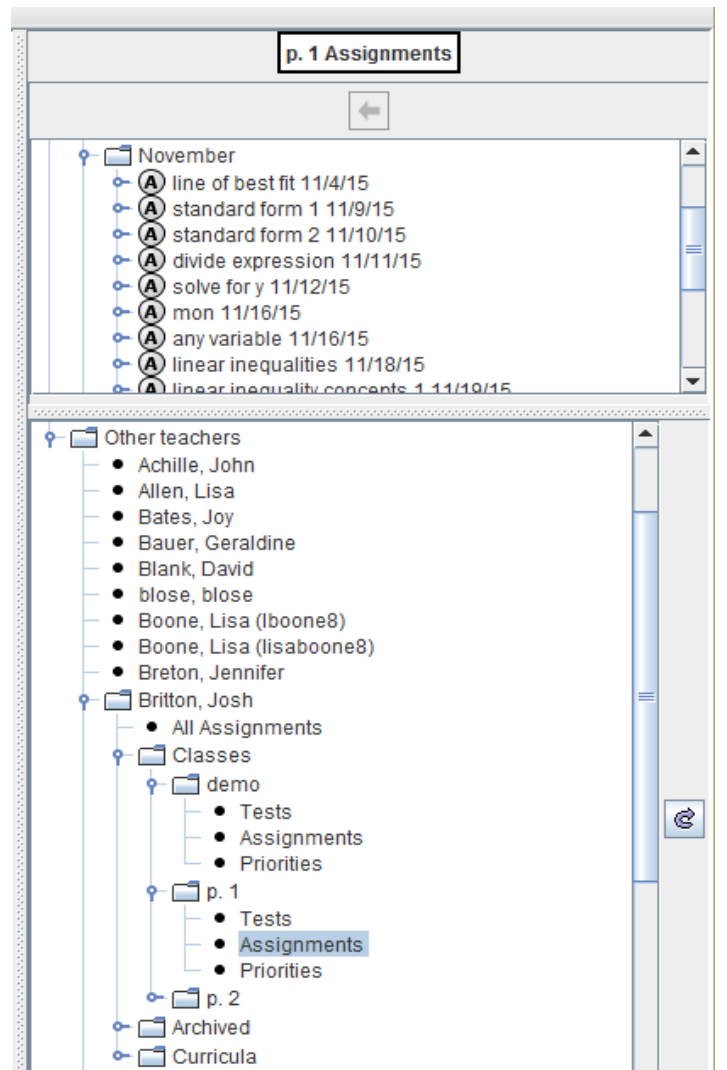
Selecting **GMM Algebra Curriculum** brings up a prepared curriculum with **Units** [U] and specific **Lessons** [L] by topic. Note that Power Point slides and relevant documents are already embedded with the lessons.



PA Algebra teachers interested in problems geared to the different sections of the Keystone Exam should select **Keystone** to view detailed lists of relevant skills.



Selecting **Multiple Choice** calls up a menu of level-specific options containing a variety of multiple choice practice problems.



If you are interested in viewing what other teachers have created, select the teacher's name from the **Other Teachers** list and continue selecting options until you see the desired assignment list. (The illustration to the right shows Josh Britton's assignments for Period 1 in November of 2015.)
