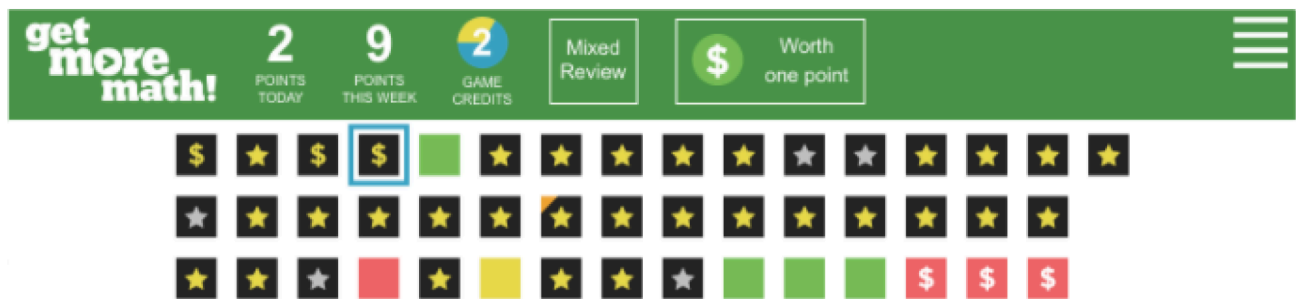


Parent Guide

Your child will be using Get More Math (GMM) this year! Get More Math is a program that provides each child with a daily individualized cumulative review session based on their specific needs. GMM shows you what skills your child has studied this year and where their strengths and weaknesses lie. Below are some tips on how you can better understand your child's progress in math class!

Understanding the Colored Squares and Symbols



■ Beginner - few completed or low accuracy
 ■ Improving - more completed, accuracy is climbing
 ■ Good - reliably accurate over several sessions

★ Excellent - many problems completed, almost all correct

★ Amazing - Tons of problems completed, almost never incorrect

★ Blue outline indicates this is the currently selected question

\$ Red outline indicates the most recent attempt was wrong and has not been fixed

Understanding the Dollar Sign

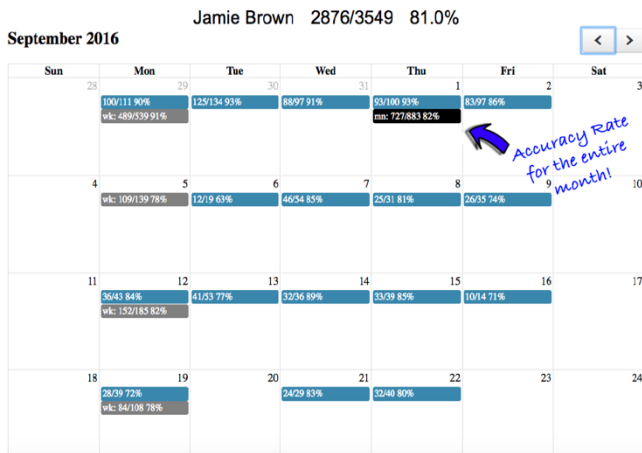
Only problems marked with a \$ are eligible for a point. To earn a point, students must work out a problem with a \$ correctly on their first attempt. If they get it wrong, they must still work it out, but it is no longer worth a point. Once they fix the mistake, the problem will once again be eligible for a point on the next attempt. Once your child has completed a problem, GMM will automatically

choose the next colored square (question) based on your child's area of greatest need.
