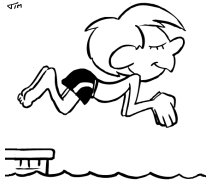


# Kick-start Summer Retention with **getM<sup>ORE</sup>emath!**



Want students to Retain the Gains they made this year?  
Worried if they don't use it, they'll lose it?



## Dive into a summer program with GMM!

Check out these options to maintain long-term retention over the summer.

### Review the Current Year

- Keep your classes active (you can archive in fall)
- Adjust the Mixed Review to reflect skills you know students need to practice and CAN complete over the summer
- Consider setting a higher number of Skips since students will be working for weeks without your help (Class - Settings)
- Make sure to SWITCH TO MIXED REVIEW so the students will have Skips available
- Set a Points Goal for the summer to incentivize practice over break
- Check Points History for the summer months to view the number of points earned by students

### Prepare for Next Year

- Keep your classes active (you can archive in fall)
- Deactivate all the skills for the class except one (you turn this skill off later)
- Create a practice set with the skills that are pre-requisite to the new year (make sure students are prepared to practice these skills)
- Click START on this practice set
- Click SWITCH TO MIXED REVIEW
- Return to your Mixed Review page and deactivate that last skill from step 2
- Set a summer Points Goal to incentivize practice over the break
- Check Points History for the summer months to view the number of points earned by students

### School-Wide Competition

- Consider archiving the current year's classes
- In one teacher's account, **create** a class and **add** all students from this grade level to this class
- Create a practice set with the skills that you want the students to maintain over the summer
- Set the number of Skips available to reflect an adequate amount given based on the number of skills in Mixed Review
- Click START on the practice set
- Click SWITCH TO MIXED REVIEW
- Have students earn points for an incentive over the summer
- Check Points History for the summer months to view the number of points earned by students
