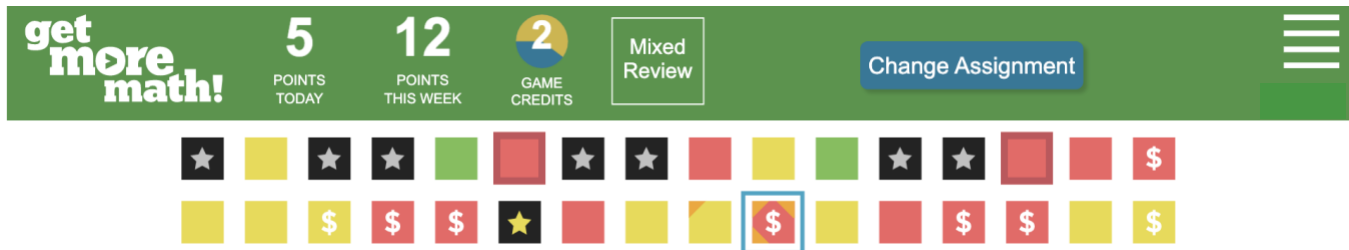


Get More Math is a program that provides your child with an individualized cumulative review session based on their specific needs. GMM shows you what skills your child has studied this year and where their strengths and weaknesses lie. Below are some tips on how you can better understand your child's progress.

Understanding the Colored Squares and Symbols



The Colored Squares	
	Beginner – few completed or low accuracy. All new skills start red
	Some progress – more completed, accuracy improving Highest color rating possible on first day
	Good – accuracy improving over multiple days
	Excellent – many problems completed, high accuracy
	Amazing – tons of problems completed, high accuracy

The Symbols on the Squares	
	Blue Outline - currently selected skill
	Red Outline - most recent attempt on this skill was incorrect and has not been fixed
	Orange Corners – a skill has been avoided. Four orange corners force the student to answer the skill if the teacher is online.

The Dollar Sign

Only problems marked with a \$ are eligible for a point. To earn a point, students must work out a problem with a \$ correctly on their first attempt. If they get it wrong, they must correct it, but it is no longer worth a point. Once they fix the mistake, the problem will once again be eligible for a point on the next attempt. Once your child has completed a problem, GMM will automatically choose the next colored square (question) based on your child's area of greatest need. In order for your child to reach their point goal, please remind them to only answer problems with \$ on them!

The student calendar shows daily goals set by your child's teacher and the sum of those goals for the week. In addition, the weekly and daily points earned, and errors fixed by your child are displayed.

To see your child's overall accuracy, choose Statistics from their menu bars.

Tips for Working at Home

Reach out to your child's teacher during their "office hours" for help. Encourage your child to use paper and pencil to show their work. Many students take a picture of their work and send it to their teacher via email, then teleconference for assistance during their office hours. Be creative and encourage communication between your child and their teacher.
