






















| | Meaning |
|---|---|
|  | RED - Beginning – few completed or low accuracy. All new skills start red. |
|  | YELLOW - Progressing – more completed, accuracy improving. Highest possible color rating on first day. |
|  | GREEN - Proficient – accuracy improving over multiple days. 3 days minimum |
|  | SILVER STAR - Excellent – many problems completed, high accuracy. 5 days minimum |
|  | GOLD STAR - Amazing – tons of problems completed, high accuracy. 7 days minimum |
|  | Dollar Sign – the skill is worth a point if answered correctly on the first attempt. The dollar sign prioritizes practice for each student. |
|  | Blue Outline - currently selected skill. |
|  | Red Outline - most recent try on this skill was incorrect and hasn't been fixed. |
|  | Orange Corners – the skill has been avoided. Four orange corners force the student to answer the skill if the teacher is online. |
|  | Penalties - GMM gives penalties on multiple choice or bi-modal questions when answered incorrectly after students have shown progress on the skill. |
|  | Each square (skill) has a unique skill code. This code can be used when creating videos or reporting issues/concerns and questions/requests. |
|  | Student Calendar – reports daily and weekly: the goal (set by the teacher), points earned, and errors fixed. |
|  | Skips - When used, the skill is removed from the practice session until the next login (grayed out). Skips are only available in Mixed Review. |
|  | Daily Goal - Total points a student must earn for the day. These points are a combination of assignment points and points earned in Mixed Review. |
|  | Switch to Mixed Review - This button will push (force) the entire class into Mixed Review. Students will still have the ability to switch to available assignments. |
|  | Hot Key – places a fraction bar in the answer box on the student screen. |
|  | Hot Key – places an exponent in the answer box on the student screen. |
|  | Hot Key – places a radical in the answer box on the student screen. |
|  | Hot Key – places a repeating decimal bar in the answer box. |
|  | Hot Key – places parentheses in the answer box on the student screen. |
|  | Hot Key – places a less than or equal to symbol in the answer box. |
