
The Colored Squares & Symbols

| \$ | red | Beginning level Few problems complete/Low accuracy |
|-------|--------------|---|
| \$ | yellow | Initial understanding/Improving accuracy Highest color rating possible on first day |
| \$ | green | Good/Initial level of proficiency Accuracy continuing to improve |
| \$ * | silver | Great/Improving proficiency Numerous problems completed |
| \$ | gold | Excellent/High level of proficiency Many problems completed |
| \$ | blue outline | Currently selected skill |
| \$ | red outline | Most recent attempt on this skill was incorrect and has not been fixed |

The Dollar Sign 🟮

Only problems marked with a \$ are eligible for a point. To earn a point, students must work out a problem with a \$ correctly on their first attempt. If they get it wrong, they must correct it, but it is no longer worth a point. Once they fix the mistake, the problem will once again be eligible for a point on the next attempt. Once your child has completed a problem, GMM will automatically choose the next colored square (question) based on your child's area of greatest need.

Other Features!



The student calendar shows daily goals set by your child's teacher and the sum of those goals for the week. In addition, the weekly and daily points earned, and errors fixed by your child are displayed. This data can be displayed throughout any month of the school year.
