Within the first three years, the pass rate on the Keystone Algebra 1 Exam was roughly 9 times that of the years preceding Get More Math implementation.




While the median predicted pass rate for this group of students was 7%, an **impressive 50%** scored proficient or better on the Keystone Algebra 1 Exam.


