



Considerations when moving to a Clever-GMM Integration

Onboarding

- **Loss of existing Student accounts** - All existing student accounts will be archived and new student accounts created using Clever's student data. Existing student progress and data will be lost.
- **Conversion of existing Teacher accounts** – If the Clever-provided email for a teacher matches the email of an existing GMM teacher account, the existing GMM account will be synced to the Clever integration. All existing Folders, Assignments and Exams from their existing GMM account will still be accessible via their new Clever account. If your user's email format in Clever is different than their standard email addresses, please notify your account manager or our [Training and Support team](#) to review.
- **Partial rostering for districts** - In some cases, school districts may choose to activate some of their schools' accounts through Clever while maintaining others through traditional GMM accounts. To preserve the existing GMM accounts, a list will need to be provided to GMM of the schools who will be retaining their existing GMM accounts.
- **Avoid oversharing of data** – If a teacher or student's data is shared with us via Clever, a user may be created for them in GMM. Please limit the sharing of data to only those schools, teachers, classes, and students that will be using Get More Math. You can contact support@getmoremath.com with any questions about this.

Ongoing

- **All class creation and rostering managed by Clever** – Clever-rostered teachers lose the flexibility of manually creating classes for differentiated instruction, which can accommodate high-achieving students or those who need remediation. With a regular GMM account this is a simple process, but this is not possible with Clever-rostered accounts; all class and student enrollment data must be managed through Clever.
- **Standard functionality not available in Clever** –
 - **Adding Co-Teachers** – Clever teachers do not have the ability to add a co-teacher to their classes. Any addition of co-teachers must be done by the school's Clever administrator through the synced data.
 - **Inability to modify class names** - GMM preserves the class names provided by Clever, which can be an issue when the classes in Clever have duplicate or similar names. In the GMM app, duplicate classes will be presented to the teacher with no clear way to differentiate between them.
 - **No manual student creation or rostering** – All student creation and addition/removal of students to classes will be managed by the data in Clever.
 - **Inability to modify student data, view/modify student usernames or reset passwords** – All changes to these items will be managed via the Clever data. Updates to the data in Clever can take up to 24 hours to sync to the GMM app.
