GMM Class Helpers Lesson Plan getMoremath!

Goal:

Motivate students to progress through the skill levels by promoting them to a Five Star General. Reward students who have earned five stars or more by allowing them to help their peers. Allowing students to help their peers saves teacher time and build community in the classroom.

Materials:

- Devices (Chromebooks/iPads/computers)
- Poster included
- Badges included
- Lanyards
- ID protective sleeve



Lesson:

- 1. As students work in GMM, take note of the students that have more than five stars on their screens.
- 2. Students with five or more stars can be promoted to a Five Star General. Students who become Five Star Generals will help their peers whenever they have a questions in GMM.
- 3. The students who are promoted to Five Star General will have their name written on the poster and will receive a lanyard with their name on it.
- 4. Five Star General promotions are fluid. Students can be promoted and demoted.



Another option: Red Pen Club

- Set criteria for students. For example, choose students who:
 - $\circ~$ Have completed the assignment or Daily Goal
 - Have more than five stars on their screen
 - Have no white or red squares, etc.
- These students receive a "special" red pen to walk around the room and help others working in GMM.
