- Proficient

SILVER



- Advanced
- Level up after a minimum of 5 days

GOLD



- Expert
- Level up after a minimum of 7 days

## Symbols



- Indicates prioritized problems worth a point when solved correctly on the first try



- Indicates an unfixed error
- May also indicate at least one penalty



- Cut corners indicate each time a skill is avoided
- Maximum of 4 avoidances



- Virtual hand raise
- Informs the teacher help is needed
