








<b>Squares</b> 	1. The squares within each section represent different students in your class.	
	What are Targeted Skills?	
<b>Assignment</b> 	2. The total of an assignment is made up of points from the Targeted Skills and from Spiral Review.	
	Who sets the points for each section?	
<b>White Squares</b> 	3. All skills that were answered incorrectly are represented by white squares.	
<b>Dollar Sign</b> 	4. Dollar-sign skills are problems that GMM has determined are best for you to practice right now.	
	List one reason why a skill may have a dollar sign on it.	
<b>Points</b> 	5. You will earn a point when you get an answer correct on any attempt.	
	What appears inside the square when you answer incorrectly?	
<b>Show Answer</b> 	6. When used, the 'Show Answer' button will also replace your current problem.	
<b>Colors</b> 	7. On the first day of practicing new skills, you may see white squares switch to either red or yellow.	
	What three color levels can be achieved after yellow?	
<b>Games</b> 	8. You earn a game credit for every 10 minutes you work in the program.	
	What is the time limit of each game?
