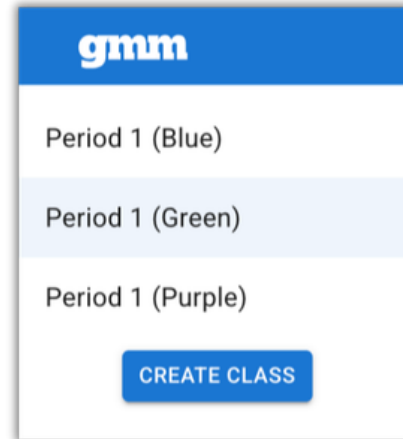
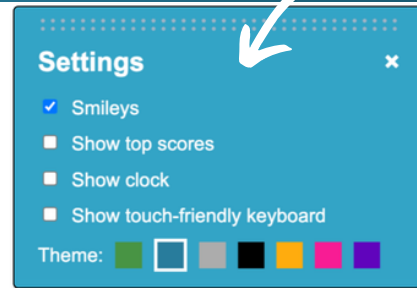


1 Create Subclasses

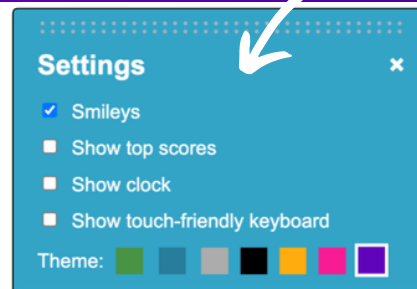
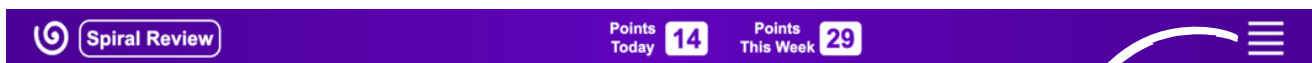
- ▶ Create an **On-Grade** Class
 - Label it as the "Green" Class
 - Example: Period 1 (Green)
 - Add **all** students to this class.



- ▶ Create a **Scaffolding** Subclass
 - Label it as the "Blue" Class
 - Example: Period 1 (Blue)
 - Add students with a **percentile < 60**
 - Have students change the color of their dashboard to **blue**

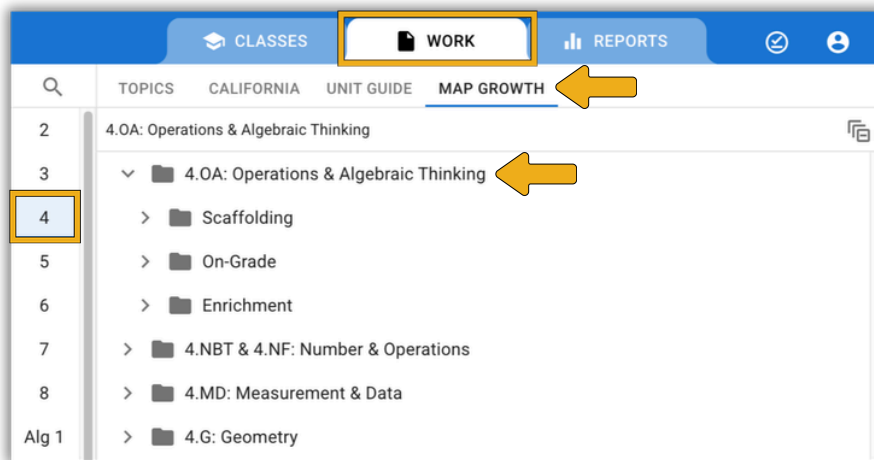


- ▶ Create an **Enrichment** Subclass
 - Label it as the "Purple" Class
 - Example: Period 1 (Purple)
 - Add students with a **percentile > 85**
 - Have students change the color of their dashboard to **purple**

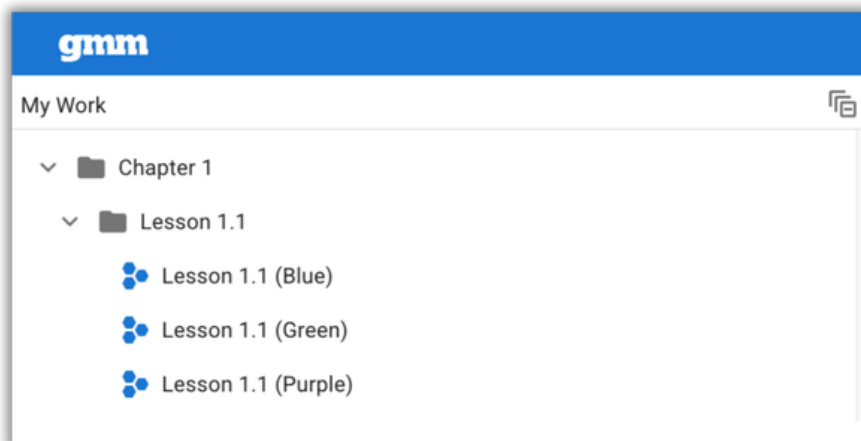


2 Create Assignments

- ▶ Create a Folder for Each Lesson
- ▶ Access the NWEA Collection
 - Choose the **Grade Level** from the center column
 - Choose the **MAP GROWTH Collection**
 - Choose the **Goal Performance Area**



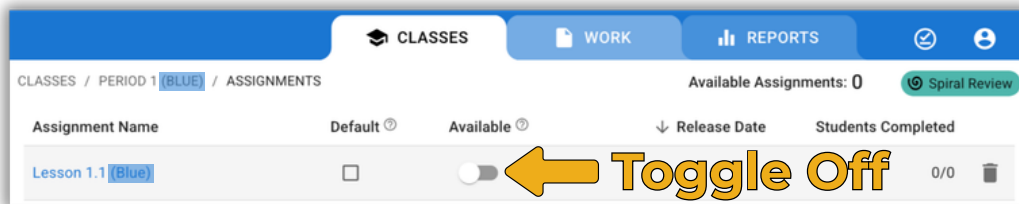
- ▶ Create Three Leveled Assignments
 - A **Blue** Assignment from the **Scaffolding** Folder
 - A **Green** Assignment from the **On-Grade** Folder
 - A **Purple** Assignment from the **Enrichment** Folder



3 Assign Work

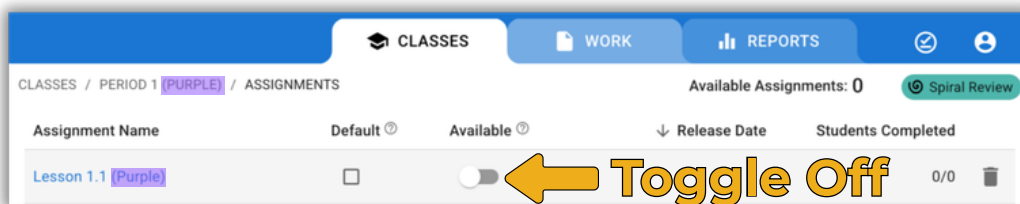
- ▶ Assign the **On-Grade** Assignment to the **Green** Class
 - **All** students should complete the On-Grade Assignment
 - We encourage students to **continue working** in Spiral Review in the Green class as much as possible.

- ▶ Assign the **Scaffolding** Assignment to the **Blue** Class
 - Make this Assignment **unavailable** in the Blue Class



- Scaffolding students will be able to **switch** to the Blue Class to work in Spiral Review when needed.

- ▶ Assign the **Enrichment** Assignment to the **Purple** Class
 - Make this Assignment **unavailable** in the Purple Class



- Enrichment students will be able to **switch** to the Purple Class to work in Spiral Review when needed.
